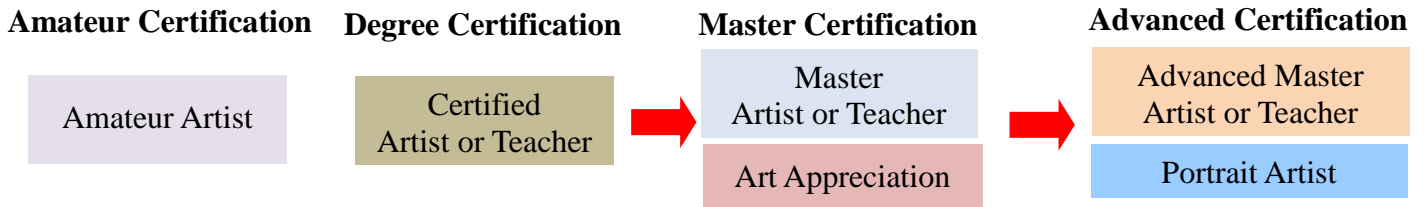


IPAT Certifications



Applicant must be a current IPAT member. Certification fee is US\$50 per application and US\$200 per Advanced Level certification application payable by PayPal, check or credit card. Certification Lesson Books are available for purchase from IPAT office. **You must be a member of good standing of IPAT in order to use IPAT's certifications, credentials and privileges.**

Amateur Artist

For beginners who admire the art of porcelain painting. Applicants must submit to Certification Screeners: Art Education Resume and proof to show applicant has actively pursued porcelain painting for at least one year; and all assignments completed as required in the *Porcelain Art: Success to IPAT Amateur Artist Certification*.



Certified Artist Requirements

1. Signatures of 3 current IPAT members
2. Photos showing you have actively exhibited porcelain art for two years
3. Resume of your Art Education, porcelain and/or other media exhibits and articles
4. Any 3 of the 4 listed requirements below:
 - A. a copy of your work shown in a recognized trade magazine, journal or paper
 - B. a newspaper clipping which shows your art or an art exhibit in which you participated
 - C. preliminary sketches to a completed original porcelain painting
 - D. a photo of your work on exhibit

Certified Teacher Requirements

1. Signatures of 3 current IPAT members to testify you have been teaching actively for 24 months
2. Photos to prove you have been actively teaching porcelain art for 24 months and currently teaching porcelain painting.
3. Resume of your Art Education, porcelain and/or other media exhibits and articles
4. Any 3 of the 4 listed requirements below:
 - A. a copy of an original, educationally directed article on porcelain art published in a trade magazine, journal or paper
 - B. a newspaper clipping which shows coverage concerning your teaching of porcelain painting
 - C. a photo of three of your students holding examples of their painting done under your guidance
 - D. photo of your teaching facility with a class in a session

Master Artist or Teacher

This is a self-education project which is both stimulating and informative. Knowledge is not only signified by the certificate issued by IPAT but by the increased confidence and knowledge gained by study, experimentation and practice. Applicant must have completed the Certified Artist or Certified Teacher Certifications. Lesson book - *Porcelain Art: Success To IPAT Master Certifications*.

Art Appreciation: Techniques Around the World

Home study is encouraged to develop specific skills in current and historic styles of painting from and around our world as well as stimulation of the current placement of porcelain art in our modern day artistic community. *Applicants must have completed certified and master certifications in either the teacher or artist categories.* Lesson book - *Porcelain Art: Success To IPAT Art Appreciation - Techniques Around the World Certification*.

Submit all assignments in A4 size book format at one time with original Submission Form to Certification Chairman or Screeners.

Applicant must have completed the Master Artist or Master Teacher Certifications. Certification is presented to those whose work passes the above requirements. Presentation will be made at each Biennial Convention Awards Banquet. It is not a requirement that the applicant be present.
